



**Electrical Arc Flash Safety**

**What is the Law and Who does it Effect?**

• Arc Flash Analysis has been addressed legislatively at both the Provincial and Federal level.

• Any and all Workers exposed to energized equipment must be trained and equipped to be protected against Arc Flash Hazards.

• An Arc Flash Analysis must be conducted on Applicable Power Distribution equipment to determine PPE

• Arc Flash Hazards affects all Workers, Supervisors, Managers and Owners

• The CSA Standard Z462-08 is now in effect and is harmonized with NFPA 70E-2009 edition.

• Ministry of Labour expect Full Arc Flash Compliance
