Mr. Paul O'Brien: J.M. Canty Inc.

Mr. Paul O'Brien works for J.M. Canty Inc. and has 21 years experience with Image Processing Systems. He has several patents for equipment design including particle sizing instrumentation for crystallization processes and random shaped 3-D particle characterization (rocks). Well versed in the mechanics of measuring particles by visual means. Current work focussing on very small (1-10 micron) dry particle measurement. He also has practical understanding on the manufacturing side as he installed a LEAN system at Canty this year that has guickly provided significant returns plant wide. Mr. O'Brien is a graduate from the Trinity College with a Bachelor of Science degree in Mechanical Engineering and M.S. Heat Transfer, SUNY at Buffalo (1984).

The presentation will cover the hardware and software used for video imaging systems to monitor and implement process control applications. Vision based systems provide non-contact measurements in real time with visual verification so that operators can view the process as the on-line measurements are made.

Vision based systems can be used in harsh environments where traditional technologies are limited. Applications range from simple level or dimensional applications which include molten steel, to complex on-line particle sizing, with shape and color analysis. The results can be output as 4-20mA or as digital signals for process control. They can be archived for a historical record keeping and storage for guality management.
