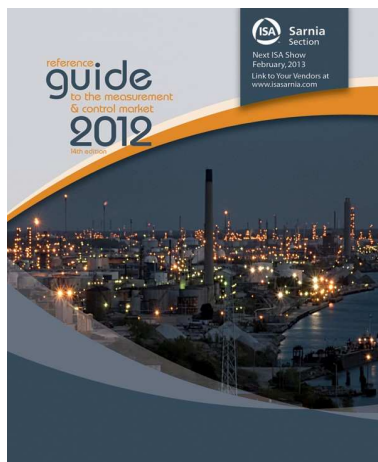
His work history along with his tenure at VEGA, gives Mr. Dyer just over 21 years of experience in the field of instrumentation.
