MAYOR MIKE BRADLEY

Born July 20th, 1955 - Adelaide, South Australia



Prior to his election as Mayor, Mr. Bradley served as the Executive Assistant to the late Honourable Justice Bud Cullen, M.P., P.C., Q.C., Member of Parliament for Sarnia-Lambton (1980 to 1985). Mr. Bradley was first elected an Alderman in the City of Sarnia in November, 1985. Mr. Bradley was elected Mayor in December, 1988. On January 1st, 1991 Mr. Bradley became the first Mayor of the amalgamated City of Sarnia-Clearwater and the first Mayor of Sarnia to serve on Lambton County Council in over seven decades. Mayor Bradley became the longest serving Mayor in Sarnia. In November, 2006 Mayor Bradley was re-elected for a seventh term with 57% of the vote.
