Hector Barresi

"Wireless Transmitters"

Wireless transmitters can measure and communicate process variables on-line without the need for wiring or external power. These transmitters give industrial users the flexibility to gather information about process and assets in areas where traditional hard-wired transmitters are too costly, difficult or time-consuming to implement. These devices can accurately monitor pressure, temperature, ultrasonic noise (for detecting steam and gas leaks), and include an analog interface to convert analog signals into wireless.

Costs and benefits related to installation, information gathering and exchange, maintenance and operations, and safety will be included. Attendees will leave with the information and tools they need to make confident and appropriate decisions about the use of wireless transmitters at their facilities. They will also understand the role these devices may play in the future.

Hector Barresi is "Product Manager for Industrial Wireless Technologies" with Honeywell Industrial Measurement and Control - Phoenix AZ. After his graduation, Mr. Barresi began his professional career, in 1980, in Industrial Automation and Control. Since he joined Honeywell in 1989 he has occupied several functions in the areas of Sales and Marketing, in four different countries. Since his move to the USA in 1997, Mr. Barresi has also occupied the positions of "Worldwide Applications Manager" and "International Sales Manager" for Latin America, Europe and Asia. Hector Barresi studied robotics at CAECE University in Buenos Aires, Argentina, and earned Bachelor's Degree in Electrical Engineering from Argentina's National Technology University. He has a Master's degree in Business Administration from France's Jules Verne University. Mr. Barresi is fluent in French, Italian, Spanish and Portuguese.
