

Guest Speaker Abstract

Jonathan Paterson

"High Definition Surveying to Reduce Risk in Project Engineering"

This presentation will address Dimensional Laser measurement or the High Definition Survey as a strategy to leverage pre-engineering and reduce risk in retrofit projects. Value engineering is realized through the use of 3D scans early from project inception. The risk of retrofits vs. the risks of Greenfield projects will be discussed. Clashes with existing plant equipment, structures and utilities are checked against new engineering layouts to avoid costly corrective field measures.

Jonathan Paterson graduated from Mohawk College in 1981 as a Mechanical Engineering Technologist. His formative years in industry with Oxford Welding & Machine Ltd. were steeped in heavy construction equipment repair, industrial installations, piping & boiler and pressure vessel repairs. Since 1993 he has managed the affairs of the industrial process division of J-Tech Design Ltd. Servicing OEM's, Owner/Operator's, Engineers and Constructors with confidence in field measurements, equipment layouts & fabrication details for prevailing condition-based projects.
