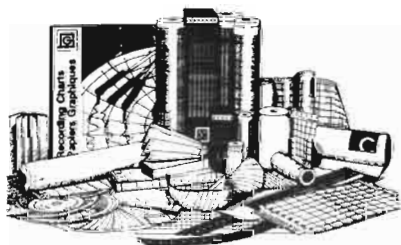

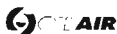

NEWS FROM THE WINTER MEETING

As your representative on the Society's Executive Board I thought you should be aware of the major topics discussed at the Board Meeting on February 17, 1993.

1. **The 1993 Budget** which we thought we had put to bed last October was revised downward as a reaction to lower than expected revenue. The revised version should produce approximately a 4% reserve.
2. **Division Dues** which have remained at \$3.00/Division since the early 1960's were the topic of much discussions. Because the subject involves money any proposal for increase must come before the Society Delegates Meeting in September. Look for a dues increase motion at the September Session.
3. A motion was introduced and accepted by the board to increase **membership dues** to \$60.00 U.S.. Here, again, as a financial item it will be voted on at the Delegates Meeting and will require 2/3 majority to pass.
4. The **European Training Centre** has had a rough time. On its first course offering it had only 9 attendees. Although well promoted, the Centre and the course offering was not well received. For the present this activity is suspended.
5. The Society has negotiated an **agreement with Alamo Car Rental** for improved rental rates. The program will reduce daily rates by \$2.00/day, 5% off weekly rates, unlimited miles, \$3000 maximum personal responsibility and credits towards Airline Frequent Flyer Plans. Be sure to mention your ISA Membership if you book an Alamo car.
6. The Board accepted recommendations from the **Organizational Structure** Implementation Task Force to; realign the Society's Finance Committee as a committee of the Executive Board.
 - To have the A&T & I&S Departments bring a recommendation to the June Meeting to add two (2) additional DVP
 - To rename publications to the Information Service Department
 - To formulate a plan to emphasize the acronym **ISA**.

These recommendations were undertaken as initial steps toward reorganization of the Society. These have begun in exploratory stages, but no doubt we will see more activity on the Restructure Concept.

These were the **Major** items of discussion. I am sure you will see much more detail on most of them coming from the June Session.

On an old subject - the Motel Property at Raleigh, N.C. that the Society purchased about a year ago has now been demolished. The grading and paving of the site will be completed later in the Spring. The project will come in below budget and will enhance the overall value of our Training Centre next to it.

The following summaries are based on recent ISA Division Newsletters:

CHEMICAL and PETROLEUM INDUSTRIES (CHEMPID)

Four scholarships were awarded for 1992, to students pursuing technical related education. CHEMPID will host five sessions at the ISA Calgary '93 Symposium, May 3-5, 1993. Thermistor Fitting Constant Calculation, Thermowell Vibration and Stress Analysis, Tank Temperature Controller Tuning and Density and Specific Gravity Conversion programming quickies were printed in the newsletter. Members were asked to return a survey to indicate interest in participating in various activities. These include technical committees, paper reviews, publications and section-division liaison. Members were asked if a PMCD Bulletin Board System would be useful.

AUTOMATIC CONTROL SYSTEMS (ACOS)
