



News Items from the Houston Conference

I attended the October 23, 1992 Executive Board Meeting as your representative and have summarized the highlights for your information:

- The Houston Show Committee reported that 33,000 persons attended the 4 day ISA 1992 Exhibit and Conference. This was the highest number ever with 17,085 visiting the Exhibit only.
- ISA budgets for a 5% reserve as its fiscal goal. Income for the 1993 fiscal year will be somewhat below expectations, however, the Board has approved the following expenditures:
 - \$35,000 for Leadership Development in the production of a videotape to enable leadership training to occur at the section level.
 - \$50,000 for the evaluation and updating of the Society's electronic media products
 - \$66,900 for the update of the business computer at ISA Headquarters

(These expenses will reduce the reserve below 5%, however, it was the feeling of the Board that all were investments in ISA's future)

Something of Special Interest to Student Members:

Student members shall be eligible at no cost, for two division memberships, one from Industries and Sciences Department and one from Automation and Technology Department. The divisions available for student membership shall be as determined annually by the respective department Vice Presidents.

On Another Note: Mr. Charles Albert, who was the DVP Elect for District 13 has announced that due to work obligations, he will be unable to assume the office of District Vice President on November 1,,1993. Nominations are being solicited at this time for the position of DVP Elect with a selection to take place at the January 1993 Council Meeting.

Active Listening for Managers

by Janet J. Zerpa and Larry R. Smeltzer

Managers are responsible for developing employees so they can accept delegation of duties and improve job efficiency or productivity. To do so, managers must have, among other abilities, the ability to communicate effectively by listening intelligently and carefully to those with whom they work.

Managers could use the information provided in this article to improve their communication skills through active listening and consequently become more effective. By listening actively they can avoid conflicts, better manage problems, increase employee morale and improve productivity.

What Is Active Listening?

Managers may need many listening skills. But the one that is most important is the one which helps employees adjust, cooperate and produce. With active listening, managers help employees gain a clearer understanding of their situations, take responsibilities and cooperate with each other.

In active listening, the listeners have a very definite responsibility. They do not passively absorb the words, but try to grasp the facts and feelings in what they hear. They try, by listening, to help the speaker work out his own problems.

Active listening does not necessarily mean long sessions spent listening to grievances, personal or otherwise. It is simply a way of approaching those problems which arise out of the usual day-to-day events of any job.

To be effective and active, listeners must want to listen. Managers cannot employ active listening as a technique if their fundamental attitudes are in conflict with its basic concepts. Their behavior will be empty and sterile, and associates will be quick to recognize this. Lack of sincerity can be easily perceived by the employee and can worsen the situation considerably. Until managers can demonstrate to employees or staff a spirit that genuinely respects their potential worth as individuals, and not just employees, which considers their rights and trusts and their capacity for self-direction, they cannot begin to be effective listeners nor effective managers.

Active listening is not an easy skill to acquire. It demands practice, results from a concentrated effort and often requires changes in basic attitudes. Some physical and psychological factor work against the process; and managers should be aware of such barriers to listening so they can develop the appropriate strategies to overcome them.

Some physical barriers to listening arise from our own limitations. We think faster than we speak. As a result, instead of listening carefully while another person is speaking, some people tend to think about other things and devote only a fraction of their capacity to thinking about what is said. Another physical barrier arises from internal distractions. Our autonomic nervous system involuntarily pays attention to certain internal events such as headache, sore feet or an empty stomach, rather than external events. Finally, any overpowering noise may compete with the main topic of interest. It is hard to listen to a subordinate who speaks softly in a noisy office.

Psychological barriers can be equally burdensome. A major psychological barrier to listening is the lack of motivation. Managers who should be listening may be day-dreaming, making private plans or even focusing on an emotional problem. Research has demonstrated that people score better on listening achievement tests when they know in advance they will be questioned on the information presented. Greater effort is exerted when the goal is known, and listeners can observe a positive outcome with such effort.

Another psychological barrier is "detouring." The listeners may become distracted by a mannerism, phrase or concept. This distraction then stimulates thought on another topic more interesting than the central topic of the message.


September Dinner Meeting Highlights
