REGIONAL PROCESS EQUIPMENT

USING THE SARNIA SECTION BBS - Part 4

Now that the basic commands and functions have been covered in previous articles, this article will address netmail and the Internet. The usefullness of a standalone BBS is limited. Sharing messages and files with other systems will give our callers a much larger audience to communicate with. While our main focus is the field of measurement and control, other areas of interest to our members are also included.

There are a number of District 13 ISA Sections that have BBS's. Toronto, Hamilton, Northern Ont., Atlantic Canada, Montreal and St. Lawrence College Student Section have BBS's utilizing different software programs. Would you like to be able to send e-mail to these and other BBS's all over North Americia, by calling your section BBS? Sounds like an interesting concept, but how can it be done? There is an existing BBS network for amateurs, called Fido Net. It is designed to be compatable with different types of computers and software. Fido also has a gateway for Internet e-mail. The Hamilton ISA BBS is already a Fido node and echo mail hub. The ISA Sarnia BBS has applied to be a Fido node in Net # 246, called Great Lakes Central based in Windsor. To send e-mail directly to other Fido nodes is called Netmail. Our BBS will have a Netmail Conference set up for this purpose. General Fido Conferences are called echo mail. That is because the messages are "echoed" across the specific network, zone or the entire Fido system. Each conference has a specific name that is consistantly used by all Fido nodes. This makes it easy to select conferences by subject area. Some examples of Fido conferences are: Baseball, CD ROM, Games, Music, Pets, Sports, World Chat, Windows 95 and many more. Each conference has a moderator to monitor messages and ensure the rules are followed. Messages travel from nodes to hubs to regional echo coordinators to the backbone and on down the rest of the system. If you enter a message it could be read at each node in the entire system. The messages could take a couple days to reach every node. Replys could also take as long to return to you. The larger BBS nodes receive echomail via a satelite transmission. A BBS system here in Sarnia, called Insomnia BBS, receives echomail via satelite. The long distance charges to receive all of the echomail can exceed the cost of the satelite receiving system. Messages are sent out by telephone lines to Windsor. Our BBS would call Insomnia BBS to pass echomail to the rest of Net 246 and the entire Fido network.

The Internet seems to be of interest to many millions of computer users these days. Articles appear in newspapers and magazines on a regular basis. Now there is one in our newsletter! <Grin>. But seriously, how can we use the Internet as a resource tool for our work in measurement and control? It can be used as the worlds largest e-mail system to communicate with ISA Headquarters, ISA Online. Industry Net and ICS Net plus any other person with an Internet address. It can be used to search for information and computer files on many subjects, including measurement and control. The Internet includes a number of different tools and systems, such as Telnet, FTP, Gopher, Archie, Veronicia, WAIS and World Wide Web (WWW). The easyest tool for the novice and the most visually stimulating is the World Wide Web. Using MS Windows ® and a Web Browser utility program and a SLIP/PPP connection for dial up access, you can surf the WWW plus all the other systems.

I wonder if there are many of you who would like to see what this is and possibly learn how to do it. If there is enough interest I would be willing to arrange a demonstration and some seminars to teach you how to utilize this technology. This fall and winter would be a good time to hold seminars.


TIME TO TEE UP!

Level Instruments Require Reducing Flanges: Instrument Tees have become an accepted product for draining fluid from the diaphragm of Level Instruments (see below). It used to be that the device did not comply with pipe specification requirements. The argument most often used was that the pipe specification break was at the vessel valve. This "reducing filler flange" now has a Canadian Registration Number which makes it acceptable to pipe specifications.


